WHEREAS, Alongside a successful career 13 in business, 14 Mr. Garza was an active member of his community; he gave generously of his time to numerous organizations, including the Gridiron 15 16 Heroes Spinal Cord Injury Foundation, Hispanic Organization Helping Others, and Toastmasters International, and he was also a 17 18 member of the Dallas Wheelchair Sidekicks quad-rugby team that won the national championship in 1989; in addition, he authored the 19 book Why Not Me? 8 Keys to Turning Tragedy into Triumph as a 20 21 testament to his journey of recovery, independence, and success; 22 and

23 WHEREAS, Babe Garza earned the admiration of all who knew him 24 through his strength of character and perseverance in the face of
