- 8 along newly laid tracks between Frio Town and Pleasanton; named for

- 10 Frio County in 1884, and the city was officially incorporated in
- 11 1909; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The Pearsall area is regarded as a "hunter's
- 13 paradise," with abundant wild game and prime hunting grounds; the
- 14 city also boasts a wide variety of agricultural products, such as
- 15 potatoes, watermelons, and specialty herbs; in addition, the city
- 16 is home to the world's largest peanut monument, which commemorates
- 17 the area's significant contributions to the peanut industry; other
- 18 attractions in Pearsall include numerous parks and the Old Frio
- 19 County Jail Museum; and
- WHEREAS, Residents of Pearsall benefit immeasurably from the
- 21 Pearsall Independent School District, which encompasses Ted Flores
- 22 Elementary, Pearsall Intermediate, Pearsall Junior High School,
- 23 and Pearsall High School; local events, such as the Hispanic
