- 1 WHEREAS, Proud residents of Tarrant County are gathering in
- 2 Austin on March 22 and 23, 2023, to celebrate Tarrant County Days at
- 3 the State Capitol; and
- WHEREAS, Created in 1849, Tarrant County has a history rooted
- 5 in the Old West, having served as the terminus point for cattle
- 6 drives during the 19th century; it was named after General Edward H.
- 7 Tarrant, who commanded Republic of Texas militia forces at the
- 8 Battle of Village Creek in 1841; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Tarrant County has transformed itself from a
- 10 frontier community into a contemporary and cosmopolitan center for
- 11 business, education, culture, and tourism; with more than 2.1
- 12 million people, it is the third-most populous county in Texas; its
- 13 county seat, Fort Worth, is the state's fifth-largest city, and
- 14 other notable communities include Arlington, North Richland Hills,
- 15 Euless, Bedford, and Keller; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Visitors from across the nation are drawn to such
- 17 exciting, family-friendly attractions as Six Flags Over Texas and
- 18 the Fort Worth Zoo, as well as to sporting events at Choctaw Stadium
- 19 and the state-of-the-art AT&T Stadium; the county also boasts among
- 20 its assets the Kimbell Art Museum, the Modern Art Museum of Fort
- 21 Worth, and the Amon Carter Museum of American Art, which enjoy an
- 22 international reputation, as well as the popular Fort Worth
- 23 Stockyards National Historical District, which celebrates the
- 24 city's unique Western heritage; and
