

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The City of Kyle dedicated its new Heroes Memorial
2 Park with a ribbon-cutting ceremony on September 11, 2022; and

3 WHEREAS, Heroes Memorial Park is designed to be a space for
4 reflection, remembrance, and celebration of the military
5 personnel, law enforcement, firefighters, and other first
6 responders who have called Kyle and Hays County home; located
7 within the city's new Brick and Mortar District, the park features a
8 memorial garden, along with educational displays and other
9 activities for visitors of all ages; and

10 WHEREAS, Part of the first phase of the Brick and Mortar
11 District, Heroes Memorial Park is situated on a 138-acre mixed-use
12 development within the Plum Creek master-planned community, which
13 will also include an event lawn and a pedestrian and bike trail; the
14 district and its accompanying park were partially funded by a tax
15 increment finance district, and guidance for the project was
16 provided by the Kyle City Council and the Tax Increment
17 Reinvestment Zone No. 2 Board; and

18 WHEREAS, Americans owe a profound debt of gratitude to the
19 military and civilian personnel who put themselves in harm's way to
20 defend our safety, security, and freedom, and Kyle's new Heroes
21 Memorial Park is a fitting tribute to the service and sacrifice of
22 those courageous men and women; now, therefore, be it
