WHEREAS, Born on January 7, 1943, Ada Edwards was raised by her grandparents in San Diego, California; soon after moving to

WHEREAS, Ms. Edwards made a successful bid for a seat on the 17 city council in 2001, and she represented District D for three 18 terms, from 2002 to 2008; over the course of her tenure, she chaired 19 council committees that addressed affordable housing, flooding 20 21 issues, and the HIV/AIDS epidemic; along the way, she demonstrated a keen ability to communicate with people from both sides of the 22 aisle and to earn the trust of residents who had historically been 23 underrepresented, which helped make her a champion for the Third 24

- 3 continued to be active in civic affairs and was appointed by Mayor
- 4 Bill White to be the assistant director of Houston's Housing and
