1 WHEREAS, The Wesley Community Center celebrated its 80th
2 anniversary on October 18, 2022, providing a fitting opportunity to
3 pay tribute to the nonprofit's outstanding contributions to the
4 Coastal Bend community; and

5 WHEREAS, In 1942, the Wesley Community Center was founded in
6 Robstown by the Women's Society of Christian Service of the First
7 United Methodist Church to serve vulnerable children in the area;
8 the organization opened a second location in Corpus Christi in
9 2001, and today, its learning centers annually serve more than 325
10 children ranging in age from two weeks to 12 years old and offer day
11 care, tutoring and homework assistance, and health and wellness
12 checkups; and

13 WHEREAS, The Wesley Community Center also established a
14 Mother and Child Home at its Corpus Christi facility to provide safe
15 and permanent housing that allows mothers and their children to
16 remain a cohesive family unit; the organization also operates food
17 pantries for low-income and homeless individuals at both of its
18 locations; and

19 WHEREAS, Over the past eight decades, the Wesley Community
20 Center has made a positive difference in the lives of countless
21 individuals and families, and its longevity is a tribute to the
22 dedication of its leadership and staff, past and present; now,
23 therefore, be it
