## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The passing of Claud Barton Jacobs on February 27,
 2023, at the age of 80, concluded a remarkable life of service to
 the Victoria community; and

WHEREAS, Born in Yoakum on July 14, 1942, Claud Jacobs was the son of Claud John Jacobs and Anna Rose Barton Jacobs; he graduated from St. Joseph High School in 1960 and went on to earn a bachelor's degree from The University of Texas at Austin, where he was senior class president; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Jacobs embarked on a 45-year career in insurance 10 and financial services in 1964, and he eventually went into 11 business for himself, forming Jacobs Insurance, which became 12 Jacobs-Weber Insurance; he was later a founding partner of 13 LodeStone Financial Services; and

14 WHEREAS, In 1972, Mr. Jacobs helped establish Bluebonnet Youth Ranch, a private care facility and long-term residential home 15 16 for mothers and families in need; over the years, it has housed more than 600 children, and he had an active role with the organization, 17 helping raise millions of dollars at its annual golf tournament 18 fundraiser and serving as a house parent, cook, and tour guide; 19 20 along the way, he helped start an endowment fund for the University 21 of Houston-Victoria athletic program and gave generously of his time and talents to several charitable organizations, including the 22 23 Boy Scouts Troop 110 of Victoria; he was recognized as a Knight of St. Gregory by Pope John Paul II for outstanding community service 24

1 and received the South Texas Council of Boy Scouts of America
2 Distinguished Citizen Award in 2018; and

7 WHEREAS, An engaged citizen, a devoted family man, and an 8 admired business leader, Claud Jacobs lived a rich and purposeful 9 life, and he will forever be remembered with deep affection by those 10 who knew and loved him; now, therefore, be it
