2 AVID program in the Lewisville Independent School District are
3 visiting the Texas Capitol on April 21, 2023; and

5 Montano, eighth-grade students at Lamar Middle have completed more
6 than 200 hours of community service as part of the Advancement Via
7 Individual Determination program, a global nonprofit organization
