- 7 1988, and he studied accounting at the University of North Texas,
- 8 where he received a master's degree in 1993; and
- 9 WHEREAS, In 1994, Mr. Powell embarked on his law enforcement
- 10 career, achieving recognition as the valedictorian and
- 11 distinguished recruit of his basic academy class with the
- 12 Lewisville Police Department; rising to the rank of assistant
- 13 police chief in 2014, he took on a broad range of duties and was
- 14 charged with oversight of the Support Operations Bureau; moreover,
- 15 he supervised officers in training, traffic, and criminal
- 16 investigations, and he was also involved in departmental issues
- 17 concerning personnel, budget, and community resources; and
- 18 WHEREAS, During his nearly three-decade-long career with the
- 19 Lewisville force, Assistant Chief Powell earned a reputation for
- 20 his bravery and integrity and for his willingness to come to the aid
- 21 of anyone in need; a graduate of the FBI National Academy, he was
- 22 widely respected, and he was honored with multiple service awards
- 23 over the course of his tenure; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Powell and his wife, Rhonda, shared a rewarding
