H.R. No. 1139

R E S O L U T I O N

1        WHEREAS, U.S. Army Chief Warrant Officer 5 Carlo Davis  
2 retired from the Fort Hood 1st Cavalry Division on March 3, 2023,  
3 concluding an exceptional military career that spanned more than  
4 three decades; and

5        WHEREAS, Carlo Davis rose through the ranks from private to  
6 sergeant first class before attending the warrant officer basic  
7 course; he has served the army in many capacities, including as  
8 battalion and battery operations sergeant, platoon sergeant, and  
9 battalion chief fire control sergeant; some of his other titles  
10 included field artillery intelligence officer and brigade and  
11 division targeting officer, and he was an instructor/writer at the  
12 Field Artillery School; on November 30, 2018, he was promoted to  
13 chief warrant officer 5, the highest warrant officer rank in the  
14 U.S. Army, which is appointed by the Secretary of the Army; only a  
15 small fraction of officers receive this rare honor; and

16       WHEREAS, Among his military assignments, Mr. Davis completed  
17 two tours at Fort Hood, four tours at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, and five  
18 overseas tours to Korea; moreover, he was deployed to Kuwait and to  
19 Iraq, and he also served with the 25th Infantry Division in  
20 Afghanistan; and

21       WHEREAS, Mr. Davis earned Veterans of Foreign Wars  
22 eligibility while serving in Korea as a member of the 2nd Infantry  
23 Division; he was later named commander of VFW Post No. 9191 in  
24 Killeen; in all his endeavors, he has enjoyed the love and support

1 of his wife, Lee Ann, and their five children; and

2 WHEREAS, Demonstrating an exceptional commitment to the  
3 mission of the U.S. Army, Carlo Davis has greatly benefited his  
4 fellow citizens, and he may indeed reflect with pride on his  
5 outstanding record of service as he embarks on the next exciting  
6 chapter of his life; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas  
8 Legislature hereby congratulate U.S. Army Chief Warrant Officer 5  
9 Carlo Davis on his retirement from the Fort Hood 1st Cavalry  
10 Division and extend to him sincere best wishes for the future; and,
