6 teacher; he previously served as an assistant principal at
7 Southside ISD and as a government and history teacher and football
8 and baseball coach in McAllen ISD; he assumed the role of
9 superintendent of Somerset ISD in 2007, and under his able
10 leadership, the district has overcome numerous challenges to earn
11 an A accountability rating from the Texas Education Agency; and

12 WHEREAS, Dr. Hinojosa plans to continue his service in the
13 field of education in his retirement; he currently works as a search
14 consultant for Walsh Gallegos, a major law firm that assists school
15 districts across the state in vetting and selecting superintendent
16 candidates; and

18 commitment to excellence, Dr. Saul Hinojosa has helped many young
19 Texans acquire the knowledge and skills necessary to succeed, and
20 his contributions will be remembered and appreciated for years to
