R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Niklas Glenesk completed the Texas  
2 Anesthesiology Policy Research Rotation Program during the 88th  
3 Texas Legislature; and

4 WHEREAS, Launched by the Texas Society of Anesthesiologists  
5 in 2023, the program offers two resident physicians each  
6 legislative session the opportunity to experience policymaking at  
7 the Capitol and learn about the political factors that impact the  
8 practice of anesthesiology; the initiative is accredited by the  
9 American Board of Anesthesiology; and

10 WHEREAS, Nik Glenesk has participated in policy meetings,  
11 developed policy materials, and testified in and attended committee  
12 hearings; in addition, he has provided updates on policy  
13 developments affecting the practice of anesthesiology to members of  
14 the TSA; and

15 WHEREAS, An Austin native, Dr. Glenesk received his  
16 bachelor's degree in chemistry with a concentration in biochemistry  
17 from George Washington University; he went on to earn his medical  
18 degree from the American University of the Caribbean School of  
19 Medicine; trained in such areas as complex trauma, neurosurgical,  
20 transplant, pediatric, cardiothoracic, and obstetric anesthesia,  
21 he has completed rotations at Lyndon B. Johnson Hospital, Texas  
22 Children's Hospital, MD Anderson, Houston Methodist, and three  
23 Memorial Hermann Hospital campuses; following the conclusion of his  
24 anesthesiology residency at The University of Texas Health Science

1 Center at Houston in June 2023, he is headed to Dallas to join Metro  
2 Anesthesia in private practice; and

3 WHEREAS, Nik Glenesk has gained valuable insight into the  
4 legislative environment and the policymaking process, and the  
5 Texas Society of Anesthesiologists is sure to benefit from his  
6 knowledgeable perspective as his career progresses; now,  
7 therefore, be it
