1           WHEREAS, J. Tom Fisher of Andrews achieved great distinction  
2 by winning the Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association Steer Roping  
3 World Championship with a triumphant performance at the 2022  
4 National Finals Steer Roping competition, held November 4 and 5 in  
5 Mulvane, Kansas; and

6           WHEREAS, Working in sync with his horse, Gump, Mr. Fisher  
7 claimed his first career gold buckle by finishing atop the PRCA  
8 world standings with \$123,477 in earnings; he arrived at NFSR in  
9 fifth place, and he reached the pinnacle with an impressive showing  
10 that included winning Rounds 5 and 10, placing in six other rounds,  
11 and finishing third in the average on nine head; his final earnings  
12 tally of \$64,575 was the highest at the event; and

13           WHEREAS, Mr. Fisher has 10 NFSR qualifications under his belt  
14 and has won a number of competitions, including the Wilson County  
15 Pro Rodeo in Fredonia, Kansas, the Jim Shoulders Living Legends Pro  
16 Rodeo in Henryetta, Oklahoma, and the West Texas Fair & Rodeo in  
17 Abilene; he is a graduate of Texas Tech University and works as an  
18 independent petroleum land man and rancher in addition to pursuing  
19 his rodeo career; and

20           WHEREAS, J. Tom Fisher is a source of great pride to his  
21 family and community, and his world championship victory has  
22 furthered the Lone Star State's reputation for rodeo excellence;
