1 WHEREAS, The girls' soccer team from Celina High School once

2 again proved itself one of the finest in Texas by winning the 2023

3 University Interscholastic League 4A state title; and

4 WHEREAS, Entering the season as the defending state

5 champions, the Bobcats took up where they left off, and over the

6 course of the 2022-2023 campaign, they scored more than 200 goals

7 while surrendering just 10; after posting an unblemished record

8 during the regular schedule, the team began its playoff run with

9 commanding wins over Nevada Community, Pinkston, Mabank,

10 Jacksonville, and Anna High Schools to advance to the state

11 tournament in Georgetown for the third consecutive year; in the

12 semifinals against Boerne, Celina won by a score of 2-0 to claim a

13 berth in the title game; and

14 WHEREAS, On April 13, Celina took the field against

15 previously undefeated Stephenville High School with the state crown

16 on the line; powered by their explosive offense, the Bobcats

17 knocked in five goals before intermission and never looked back;

18 the team ultimately triumphed 8-1 and set several Class 4A records

19 in the process, including most goals and assists in a championship

20 game; with the victory, Celina extended its winning streak to 50

21 games and became the third girls' team in UIL history to finish a

22 season with no losses and no ties on its record; and
