- 1 WHEREAS, Former Harris County Sheriff and Precinct 4
- 2 Constable Ron Hickman is being presented with the inaugural Living
- 3 Legend Award from the Justices of the Peace and Constables

- 5 WHEREAS, Ron Hickman embarked on his career in law
- 6 enforcement with the Houston Police Department in 1971, and he
- 7 served as an accident investigator, patrol officer, underwater
- 8 search and recovery officer, and bomb squad technician; he
- 9 eventually joined the planning and research division, where he
- 10 helped build computer systems to aid law enforcement operations;

- WHEREAS, In 1983, Mr. Hickman became a member of the Harris
- 13 County Precinct 4 Constable's Office, quickly rising to the rank of
- 14 sergeant; in 2000, he was elected as the Precinct 4 constable, and
- 15 he was reelected four times, holding that title until 2015; he
- 16 worked with constables across the state to enhance qualifications
- 17 and standards for the job, and he served on the Constable's
- 18 Legislative Committee; and
- 19 WHEREAS, In May 2015, Mr. Hickman was appointed sheriff of
- 20 Harris County; during his 18-month tenure, he launched a program to
- 21 train officers in de-escalation techniques, created a citizen
- 22 review board, and helped develop protocols for identifying and
- 23 treating mental illness within the Harris County Jail inmate
- 24 population; and
