R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Captain Erick E. Erinna Sr. of the U.S. Army is being
2 honored for his leadership as company commander of the Houston
3 Medical Recruiting Station during his change of command ceremony on
4 June 9, 2023; and

5 WHEREAS, Captain Erinna will officially take on his new
6 assignment as career manager at the Army Human Resources Command in
7 Fort Knox, Kentucky, on June 26, 2023, bringing a wealth of
8 experience from his current role as company commander; over the
9 course of his two-year tenure, he has overseen targeted recruiting
10 operations in three states, and he has supervised a team of 5
11 officers, 18 noncommissioned officers, and 3 civilians; under his
12 able leadership, the company has annually commissioned more than 70
13 health care professionals in over 41 occupational specialties of
14 the U.S. Army and the U.S. Army Reserve; and

16 Company, Captain Erinna served as a deputy chief human resources
17 officer for the 804th Medical Brigade in Massachusetts, a battalion
18 adjutant for the 439th Multifunctional Medical Battalion in New

20 Department in Oklahoma; his many military honors include a 2021
21 General Douglas MacArthur Leadership Award, Recruiting Gold Badge,
22 Recruiting Ring, the Joint Service Commendation Medal, the Army
23 Commendation Medal, the Army Achievement Medal, and the Good
24 Conduct Medal; and

1 WHEREAS, Captain Erinna holds a bachelor's degree and a
2 master's degree in business administration from Ashworth College in
3 Norcross, Georgia; he plans to pursue a doctoral degree in
4 business; and

6 mission of the U.S. Army, Captain Erick Erinna has greatly
7 benefited his fellow citizens, and he may indeed reflect with pride
8 on his outstanding record of service as he takes on the challenges
