1 WHEREAS, Meghna Kumar of Argyle High School achieved great
2 distinction by winning the 5A singles championship at the 2023
3 University Interscholastic League Tennis State Tournament; and

4 WHEREAS, Joining the other top high school players in Texas
5 on April 25 and 26 in San Antonio, Ms. Kumar delivered an
6 exceptional performance; dominating her opponents as she advanced
7 through the bracket, she won her quarterfinal and semifinal matches
8 in straight sets over opponents from Friendswood and Boerne
9 Champion High Schools; squaring off against Frisco Wakeland High
10 School's Ella Wertz in the final, she secured a commanding 6-1, 6-2
11 victory to clinch the title and end a storybook season in which she
12 didn't lose a single set; and

13 WHEREAS, With the championship victory, Ms. Kumar collected
14 her second straight singles state title after earning the 2021-2022
15 Class 4A crown, the first in school history; she also helped the
16 Eagles advance to the 2021 Team Tennis State Tournament, where the
17 squad claimed the 4A silver medal; she is ably guided by Argyle
18 coaches Danielle Blair and Adam Mihok; and

19 WHEREAS, By excelling in the state's premier showcase for
20 high school tennis players, Meghna Kumar has ably represented her
21 school and community, and she will cherish her memories of this
22 outstanding accomplishment for years to come; now, therefore, be it
