14 manager for Tricon Residential, where he was recognized as a
15 talented employee and an asset to the company; he learned a variety

18 Painting, he performed work on many homes throughout the
19 Dallas/Fort Worth area; and

21 shoes, and he also had a passion for classic cars; an avid sports
22 fan, he enthusiastically cheered on his favorite teams, the Dallas
23 Cowboys and the Los Angeles Lakers; he was devoted to his family and
24 loyal to his friends, and he was known for his kindness, compassion,
