1 WHEREAS, Heider Garcia is concluding his exemplary tenure as 2 Tarrant County elections administrator on June 23, 2023; and 3 WHEREAS, Widely recognized as a leader in his field, Mr. Garcia was hired by Tarrant County in 2018; he implemented the 4 new Electronic Poll Book platform, advanced the process for 5 purchasing new voting equipment, and successfully advocated for 6 adoption of the Vote Centers model of voting, also known as 7 countywide polling; in 2020, Tarrant County earned an Achievement 8 Award from the National Association of Counties in the category of 9 Information Technology for Modernizing Election Systems; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Under Mr. Garcia's leadership as administrator, the 12 county also received positive reviews from a state audit of the 2020 voting process, and former Texas Secretary of State John B. Scott 13 14 praised his performance as a model for all to emulate; Mr. Garcia has demonstrated a great willingness to address the concerns of 15 16 citizens, answering their questions and welcoming them to tour elections facilities and review records; he serves as vice 17 president of the Texas Association of Elections Administrators; and 18 WHEREAS, Previously, Mr. Garcia was the elections manager 19 for Placer County, California, and he served as election systems 20 21 manager for the project team that ran the 2010 automated elections in the Philippines, a country of more than 50 million registered 22 23 voters; he was responsible for customizing the technology, certifying the solution under VVSG standards in the United States, 24

- 1 and ensuring total compliance with local legislation; at the end of
- 2 the project, he responded to the information requests from the
- 3 nation's legislative oversight committees; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Born in Pennsylvania, Mr. Garcia earned his
- 5 bachelor's degree in computer engineering from Simon Bolivar
- 6 University in his parents' native Venezuela; he began working as a
- 7 software developer for a company that entered the elections
- 8 business, and he was placed in charge of voting machine deployment
- 9 and certification for 12 nationwide election processes; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Heider Garcia has greatly benefited residents of
- 11 Tarrant County through his skill, expertise, and steadfast
- 12 dedication to the efficiency, accuracy, and transparency of the
- 13 elections process, and his contributions have earned the admiration
- 14 of citizens and professional colleagues alike, in Tarrant County
- 15 and beyond; now, therefore, be it
