1 WHEREAS, Eleanor Archer and Morgan Rose of Amarillo High
2 School achieved great distinction by winning the 5A girls' doubles
3 championship at the 2023 University Interscholastic League Tennis
4 State Tournament; and

5 WHEREAS, Joining the other top high school players in Texas
6 on April 25 and 26 in San Antonio, Ms. Archer and Ms. Rose delivered
7 an exceptional performance; dominating their opponents as they
8 advanced through the bracket, the Amarillo duo won their
9 quarterfinal and semifinal matches in straight sets over opponents
10 from Frisco Lebanon Trail and Boerne Champion High Schools to set up
11 a championship battle against Frisco Liberty High School;
12 demonstrating great resolve after dropping the first set,
13 Ms. Archer and Ms. Rose staged an impressive rally, emerging
14 triumphant by the score of 5-7, 6-4, 6-1 to clinch the 5A gold
15 medal; and

16 WHEREAS, With the state championship victory, Ms. Archer and
17 Ms. Rose compiled an outstanding 37-1 record in doubles for the
18 spring season and wrapped up a remarkable 66-1 ledger for the
19 2022-2023 fall and spring seasons combined; Ms. Archer became a
20 three-time state champion for her high school career, having
21 previously collected gold medals in singles and mixed doubles; and

22 WHEREAS, By excelling in the state's premier showcase for
23 high school tennis players, Eleanor Archer and Morgan Rose have
24 ably represented their school and community, and they will cherish

1 their memories of this outstanding accomplishment for years to
2 come; now, therefore, be it
