15 distinguished himself through his involvement with United Way of  
16 Hays and Caldwell Counties as well as Centro Cultural Hispano de San  
17 Marcos; in addition, he serves as chief of staff in the office of  
18 State Representative Erin Zwiener, and he has demonstrated an  
19 outstanding commitment to supporting constituents and calling  
20 attention to the needs of his fellow Texans; he holds a bachelor's  
21 degree in public administration from Texas State University; and

22           WHEREAS, Miguel Arredondo's dedication and visionary  
23 leadership have made him a valued member of the San Marcos CISD  
24 school board, and he may indeed reflect with pride on his
