3 to the city; and

5 he completed the unexpired term of the late Walter Schwartz, and he
6 was elected to his first full term in 2005; demonstrating strong
7 leadership over the course of his tenure, he has ably guided the
8 city's growth and served his fellow citizens with distinction; and

9 WHEREAS, In addition to his responsibilities as mayor,
10 Mr. Tate has enjoyed a successful legal career; he has worked in
11 private practice and previously served as county attorney for
12 Washington County and as city attorney for the City of Brenham; over
13 the years, he has given generously of his time and talents to the
14 Brenham Rotary Club and several organizations affiliated with The
15 University of Texas; moreover, he is a former member of the board of
16 directors of the Lower Colorado River Authority, the
17 Brenham/Washington County Economic Development Organization, and
18 Trinity Medical Center; he holds a bachelor's degree in business
19 administration from UT, and he is a 1963 graduate of the UT School
20 of Law; and

21 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Tate enjoys the love and
22 support of a fine family that includes his wife, Twila, and their
23 daughters and grandchildren; and

24 WHEREAS, Milton Tate has greatly benefited the residents of

1 Brenham through his visionary leadership, expertise, and
2 commitment to excellence, and he may indeed reflect with pride on
3 his many contributions as he begins the next exciting chapter of his
4 life; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas
6 Legislature hereby commend Milton Y. Tate Jr. on his service as
7 mayor of Brenham and extend to him sincere best wishes for the
8 future; and, be it further
