- 17 as chair of the Tyler Together Race Relations Forum; moreover, he
- 18 was active with such groups as the League of Women Voters, March of
- 19 Dimes, and East Texas Wheelers and Walkers; and

- 21 not only for his professional accomplishments but also for his
- 22 exceptional kindness and generosity, and he leaves behind a legacy
- 23 that will resonate in the Tyler community for years to come; now,
