1 WHEREAS, The Bellaire City Library has received a 2022
2 Achievement of Excellence in Libraries Award from the Texas

5 annually presents the Achievement of Excellence in Libraries Award
6 to institutions that distinguish themselves in each of 10
7 categories, including collaborative efforts with local
8 organizations, outreach to underserved populations, literacy and
