21 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Tinsley benefited from the 22 love and support of his family, which included his 3 children, 23 Laura, Bill, and John, and his 10 grandchildren and 4 24 great-grandchildren; he took many hunting and fishing trips to
