- 17 of changes that led to the establishment of new industry safety

- 19 moreover, he created the TXOGA Insurance Agency and the TXOGA
- 20 Workers' Compensation Safety Group; additionally, he served on the
- 21 Interstate Oil and Gas Compact Commission and with the U.S. Oil &
- 22 Gas Association; upon his retirement in 2014, he was honored with
- 23 the prestigious TXOGA Distinguished Service Award; and
- WHEREAS, In retirement, Mr. Looney served the Evant Chamber

- 1 of Commerce as president, and he helped put into place the Evant
- 2 Independent School District Heritage Foundation; in all his
