

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, Taylor Nunez of Randolph High School in Universal  
2 City achieved great distinction by winning four gold medals at the  
3 2023 University Interscholastic League Track & Field State Meet;  
4 and

5           WHEREAS, Joining the other top high school competitors in  
6 Texas at Mike A. Myers Stadium in Austin on May 11, Ms. Nunez  
7 captured three of her gold medals in individual events; she set  
8 Class 3A state meet records in the long jump by soaring 20 feet, 2.5  
9 inches, as well as in the 100-meter dash with a time of 11.44  
10 seconds, breaking the meet mark she set at last year's competition;  
11 moreover, she won the 200 meters with a blistering time of 23.42  
12 seconds, which would have resulted in another record had it not been  
13 ruled to be aided by the wind; and

14           WHEREAS, In the 400-meter relay, Ms. Nunez ran the anchor leg  
15 for the Randolph squad, and she and teammates Jaela Smith, Cai  
16 Rogers, and Jourdann Cathro collected the state crown with a total  
17 time of 47.27 seconds; the victory was part of dominant showing by  
18 the Ro-Hawk athletes, who clinched the 3A team championship by a  
19 wide margin; and

20           WHEREAS, Ms. Nunez is continuing a family tradition with her  
21 success in track and field; her mother, Tameka Nunez, was a  
22 seven-time All-American while competing for The University of Texas  
23 at San Antonio under her maiden name, Tameka Roberts; and

24           WHEREAS, By excelling in the state's premier showcase for

1 high school track and field athletes, Taylor Nunez has ably  
2 represented her school and community, and she will cherish her  
3 memories of this outstanding accomplishment for years to come; now,  
4 therefore, be it

5         RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas  
6 Legislature hereby congratulate Taylor Nunez on winning four gold  
7 medals at the 2023 UIL Track & Field State Meet and extend to her  
8 sincere best wishes for continued success; and, be it further

9         RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
10 prepared for Ms. Nunez as an expression of high regard by the Texas  
11 House of Representatives.
