1 WHEREAS, Gruver Elementary School and Gruver Junior High
2 School in the Gruver Independent School District have both been
3 named National Blue Ribbon Schools; and

4 WHEREAS, The National Blue Ribbon Schools Program was created
5 by the U.S. Department of Education in 1982 to recognize campuses
6 that have demonstrated superior academic performance or made
7 notable progress in improving outcomes among economically
8 disadvantaged students; one of the most prestigious honors an
9 elementary or secondary school in the United States can receive,
10 the Blue Ribbon designation is awarded each year to only a select
11 number of campuses nationwide; and

12 WHEREAS, Gruver Elementary School and Gruver Junior High
13 School, led by principals Amber Holland and Lexy Glass,
14 respectively, were designated as Blue Ribbon Schools in 2022;
15 Gruver Elementary serves students in prekindergarten through the
16 fourth grade, while Gruver Junior High serves students in fifth
17 through eighth grade; and

18 WHEREAS, Through hard work and perseverance, the teachers and
19 students of these exemplary campuses have established a record of
20 scholastic excellence, and their outstanding efforts have been duly
21 recognized with the Blue Ribbon School award; now, therefore, be it
