WHEREAS, In the individual events, Indyia Walton added to the Pantherettes' winning total; she collected the bronze medal in the 300-meter hurdles with a time of 42.44 seconds and earned fourth place in the 100-meter hurdles, finishing in 14.13 seconds; Duncanville also received valuable contributions throughout the season from Kennedy Brown, who ran with the 800-meter and 1,600-meter squads; and
