- 5 the 138-pound division and Jackson Moss in the 165-pound division;
- 6 Dumas was also represented at state by Brandon Smith at 132 pounds,
- 7 Ezven Venzor at 144 pounds, and Alberto Sanchez at 190 pounds; the
- 8 Demons were guided by head coach Sion King in his inaugural season
- 9 at the helm of the program; and
