R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The city of Houston lost a respected business and  
2 civic leader with the death of Alex Wang, who passed away on  
3 April 30, 2023, at the age of 59; and

4 WHEREAS, Alex Wang was born in November 1964 in Hefei, Anhui,  
5 China; after studying in the Department of Radio Electronics at the  
6 University of Science and Technology of China, he began his career  
7 as an assistant engineer at the Hefei Microcomputer Research  
8 Institute; in 1990, he immigrated to the United States and enrolled  
9 at the University of Houston, where he earned a master's degree in  
10 computer science in 1997; and

11 WHEREAS, The founder and president of Z & ZZ International,  
12 Mr. Wang designed and maintained websites for numerous companies,  
13 and he also devoted himself to the online news industry as the  
14 founder and editor in chief of the World Hall of Fame network, for  
15 which he wrote many Chinese-language articles that were popular  
16 worldwide; and

17 WHEREAS, Dedicated to serving the Chinese American community  
18 in the U.S. and to promoting Chinese culture around the world,  
19 Mr. Wang took an active role in helping Chinese immigrants succeed  
20 in the U.S.; moreover, he held leadership roles with a number of  
21 worthy organizations, serving as secretary-general of the Anhui  
22 Association of Texas and as deputy executive director of the  
23 Chinese Civic Center in Houston; and

24 WHEREAS, Mr. Wang and his first wife, Zhong Zhang, were

1 blessed with a daughter, Winnie Wang; though their marriage later  
2 ended, he went on to enjoy a richly rewarding union with his second  
3 wife, Bo Lu, who spent many years working behind the scenes to  
4 support her husband's media platform and civic endeavors; and

5 WHEREAS, The loss of Alex Wang is keenly felt by the numerous  
6 friends and colleagues that he made through the years as well as by  
7 the countless people in Texas and beyond whose lives he forever  
8 enriched; now, therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas  
10 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Alex Wang and extend  
11 sincere condolences to his family and friends; and, be it further

12 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
13 prepared for his family and that when the Texas House of  
14 Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of Alex Wang.
