6 management in 1981; he went on to earn his doctor of jurisprudence
7 degree from South Texas College of Law Houston in 1988, and he was
8 admitted to the State Bar of Texas the following year; and

9 WHEREAS, In 1994, Mr. Cox established the Cox Law Firm, and
10 he also taught business law in the HBU master's degree program;
11 actively involved with his alma mater, he served for a total of 20
12 years on the Houston Baptist University Board of Trustees,
13 including two terms as its chair, and he was a member of the HBU
14 Alumni Association Advisory Board as well; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Cox balanced his career with a rewarding home
16 life as a servant of Christ with his wife, Dr. Barbara Taylor Cox,
17 with whom he shared four decades of marriage, and he was a devoted
18 father to their two sons, Tyler and Colton; and

20 were privileged to share in his love and friendship will forever
21 remember him with admiration and affection; now, therefore, be it
