## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Frank B. Ashley III is retiring as senior

2 professor and executive associate dean of the Texas A&M University

3 Bush School of Government and Public Service in 2023, following a

4 distinguished career spanning more than four decades in education

5 and nearly 35 years with the TAMU System; and

6 WHEREAS, Since joining the Bush School in 2016, Dr. Ashley

7 has overseen such areas as graduate education and research

8 activities, strategic planning, and program development; he has

9 also taught courses in his role as senior professor, worked to

10 foster diversity and inclusion, and strengthened the school's

11 external relations; and

12 WHEREAS, Dr. Ashley earned his bachelor's degree in health,

13 physical education, and safety at Louisiana College, and after

14 beginning his career as a science teacher and coach in Louisiana, he

15 completed his master's and doctoral degrees at the University of

16 Alabama; in 1986, he was hired by TAMU as an assistant professor in

17 the Department of Health and Kinesiology and coordinator of the

18 sport management program; and

19 WHEREAS, A gifted administrator, Dr. Ashley was named

20 associate dean for undergraduate studies and teacher education in

21 the College of Education in 1996; he went on to serve in a number of

22 leadership positions, and during three years at TAMU-Commerce, he

23 rose to become interim provost and vice president for academic

24 affairs; active in the community, he served as a trustee of the

- 1 Commerce Independent School District and spoke to students and
- 2 educators across the region; he returned to College Station in 2007
- 3 as a vice chancellor for the A&M System; from 2013 to 2016, he was a
- 4 senior vice president at the College Board in New York, working on
- 5 initiatives to increase college participation for underprivileged
- 6 students; and
- WHEREAS, Over the years, Dr. Ashley has been published
- 8 extensively; he has presented frequently in the U.S. and abroad and
- 9 is much in demand as a speaker on education, conflict resolution,
- 10 and diversity issues; inducted into the University of Alabama
- 11 College of Education Hall of Fame, he is the recipient of myriad
- 12 other accolades, including the Distinguished Service Award from the
- 13 Faculty Senate of TAMU-Commerce; he was named vice chancellor
- 14 emeritus by the TAMU System in 2013; and
- WHEREAS, Deeply committed to the important mission of Texas
- 16 A&M University, Frank Ashley has made significant contributions to
- 17 the advancement of higher education, and he may indeed reflect with
- 18 pride on a career well spent; now, therefore, be it
