24 Ms. Montemayor taught at middle schools in the

1 Grapevine-Colleyville, Keller, and Birdville Independent School  
2 Districts; a former Division I track and field athlete, she later  
3 served as a coach for a wide variety of sports, and she is active in  
4 her church and community; during her leisure hours, she likes to  
5 dance, exercise, write, and spend time outdoors; and

6 WHEREAS, Destiny Montemayor has performed her duties as a  
7 legislative assistant with skill and dedication, and she is indeed  
8 deserving of special recognition for her fine work; now, therefore,  
9 be it
