## RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, The Amarillo Symphony is celebrating the 100th
- 2 anniversary of its founding throughout its 2023-2024 season; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The only professional symphony in the Texas
- 4 Panhandle region, the Amarillo Symphony traces its origins to 1924,
- 5 when a 12-member group of musicians known as the Philharmonic Club
- 6 began playing special concerts for residents in their homes; by
- 7 1926, the club had a full-time conductor, Ellis B. Hall, the first
- 8 in a long line of maestros who have helped transform the group into
- 9 a full-fledged, professional symphonic ensemble; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In the late 1960s, the Philharmonic changed its name
- 11 to the Amarillo Symphony; in 1968, it began playing in the Amarillo
- 12 Civic Center Auditorium, which served as its home for nearly four
- 13 decades, until the symphony moved to the Globe-News Center for the
- 14 Performing Arts in 2006; and
- WHEREAS, The Amarillo Symphony has grown alongside the
- 16 25,000-square-mile region that it serves, and today, it consists of
- 17 85 musicians who perform eight-concert seasons; the symphony is
- 18 committed to not only providing diverse, engaging, and inspiring
- 19 musical experiences to the public, but also fostering music
- 20 education through initiatives and events such as its Youth
- 21 Orchestra, Class Act program, educational concerts, and Greater
- 22 Southwest Music Festival; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Over the course of the past century, the Amarillo
- 24 Symphony has become an important part of the cultural fabric of the

- 1 Panhandle region, and it is a pleasure to join in celebrating the
- 2 longevity of this cherished institution and the many ways it has
- 3 enriched the community; now, therefore, be it
