R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Xavier Herrera was reelected to the Stafford City
2 Council on May 6, 2023; and

3 WHEREAS, First elected in 2021, Mr. Herrera serves in council
4 position no. 5, and he was recently named mayor pro tem; and

5 WHEREAS, In fulfilling the duties of his office, Mr. Herrera
6 draws on a wealth of valuable experience; he is an alumnus of the
7 University of Houston, where he studied political science, and he
8 has held several positions with the City of Houston and Harris
9 County; moreover, he has served as communications director for the
10 Fort Bend County Judge's Office and is a former trustee of the
11 Stafford Municipal School District, which he helped lead as vice
12 president and board secretary; he has also chaired the Stafford
13 Planning and Zoning Commission and been involved with a number of
14 local educational boards and development councils; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Herrera is a member of numerous civic
16 organizations, including the National Association of Latino
17 Elected and Appointed Officials, the Playworks Texas board of
18 directors, and the Texas Association of School Boards, which has
19 designated him as a master trustee; in addition, he gives
20 generously of his time and expertise to such charitable groups as
21 the Gulfton Area Student Mentoring Program, Special Olympics Texas,
22 and Rebuilding Together Houston; and

23 WHEREAS, Each day, public servants improve the quality of
24 life for their fellow citizens in innumerable ways, and the

1 continuing efforts of Xavier Herrera will help to make Stafford an
2 even better place in which to live and work; now, therefore, be it
