## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The city of Fort Worth lost a beloved community 2 leader with the passing of Daniel M. Jensen on December 5, 2021, at 3 the age of 66; and

WHEREAS, The son of Elwood and Elaine Jensen, Danny Jensen was born on July 24, 1955, and he grew up with the companionship of his brother, David; he graduated from Alamo Heights High School in San Antonio in 1973, and he went on to earn a bachelor's degree from Texas Tech University as well as a master's degree from Texas Christian University; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Jensen began his career with the Texas College 10 of Osteopathic Medicine at the University of North Texas Health 11 12 Science Center at Fort Worth in 1984, and he initially served as director of development and executive director of the foundation; 13 in 1990, he became the vice president for governmental affairs for 14 HSC, and he was later appointed the associate vice chancellor for 15 16 governmental relations; over the course of his nearly four decades 17 of service, he spearheaded legislative strategy that was central to the growth of a significantly larger and more diverse HSC; he played 18 an instrumental role in gaining support for a number of new 19 facilities on campus and for the establishment of the Graduate 20 21 School of Biomedical Sciences, the School of Public Health, the School of Health Professions, and the UNT System College of 22 23 Pharmacy; he collaborated with local, state, and federal officials as well as with other community leaders to advance HSC, the City of 24

1 Fort Worth, and higher education in Texas; as part of HSC's 50th 2 Anniversary, he was designated as one of the school's "50 Heroes"; 3 and
