16 WHEREAS, Judge Staudt has given generously of her time and talents to myriad civic and charitable organizations, among them 17 the National Day of Prayer, Safe & Drug Free School Committee, Twin 18 Lakes YMCA Advisory Board, and Leadership Circle-Texas Alliance for 19 20 Life; in addition, she has been very involved in Republican Party politics, serving in such capacities as precinct chair, election 21 judge, senatorial district convention chair, and Republican State 22 23 Convention delegate; she has been a volunteer and coordinator for campaigns at the local, state, and national level, and she is a 24

1 cofounder of Leander Area Republican Women; named Cedar Park 2 Citizen of the Year, she is the recipient of numerous accolades, 3 including the Williamson County Republican Leaders Leadership 4 Award, Glenn Shepard Servant Leadership Award, and Hill Country 5 Community Ministries Heart of Hope Award; and

6 WHEREAS, Before embarking on her long career in public 7 service, Judge Staudt was a real estate mortgage broker and 8 entrepreneur; she and her husband are the parents of six children, 9 and their family further includes their 12 grandchildren; a member 10 of the Williamson County Cowboy Church, Judge Staudt serves on the 11 music ministry team; and

12 WHEREAS, Edna Staudt has greatly benefited the citizens of 13 Williamson County through her wide-ranging contributions, and her 14 accomplishments will continue to resonate in the years to come; 15 now, therefore, be it
