9 area during the AIDS epidemic, and in 1994, she began practicing as  
10 a registered nurse in Texas; and

17 legislative session, Katherine Lindley has helped to ensure the  
18 well-being and productivity of the legislative community, and her  
19 dedication has earned her the respect and appreciation of all who  
20 know her; now, therefore, be it
