

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, U.S. Army Colonel (Ret.) William L. Moseley has
2 rendered exceptional service to the military community through his
3 role as director of the St. Philip's College Good Samaritan
4 Veterans Outreach and Transition Center in San Antonio; and

5 WHEREAS, The Good Samaritan Veterans Outreach and Transition
6 Center opened in 2017 with Bill Moseley taking the helm as director;
7 benefiting active duty military personnel, veterans, and their
8 families, the facility provides a range of vital resources,
9 including job training, financial and educational counseling,
10 health and legal services, and referral services, all at no cost;
11 since its inception, the center has served more than 44,000
12 individuals in the greater San Antonio area; and

13 WHEREAS, Among the center's other achievements, it has
14 engaged with some 25,000 military personnel at over 900 veteran
15 community events; it has also conducted more than 1,000 workshops
16 and related initiatives as well as 5 state veterans fairs; in
17 addition, the facility has expanded its classroom seating capacity
18 and has upgraded classrooms and conference rooms with equipment
19 necessary for hybrid workshops and other events; and

20 WHEREAS, A native of San Antonio, Colonel Moseley worked as a
21 firefighter before entering the U.S. Army; he was commissioned as a
22 second lieutenant and went on to become a logistics officer,
23 distinguishing himself in the roles of company, battalion, and
24 brigade commander; prior to his retirement in 2013, he spent 25

1 years in critical and key assignments around the world; and

2 WHEREAS, Through his exemplary efforts, Bill Moseley is
3 helping to ensure that those who have courageously served our
4 nation are afforded the support and assistance they need, and it is
5 indeed a privilege to honor him for his myriad contributions; now,
6 therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas
8 Legislature hereby commend Colonel (Ret.) William L. Moseley for
9 his adept leadership as director of the St. Philip's College Good
10 Samaritan Veterans Outreach and Transition Center and extend to him
11 sincere best wishes for continued success; and, be it further

13 prepared for Colonel Moseley as an expression of high regard by the
14 Texas House of Representatives.
