RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, On September 17, 1787, our nation's foundational
- 2 document was signed by 39 brave men who changed the course of
- 3 history, and each year, we celebrate the anniversary of that
- 4 momentous milestone as Constitution Day; and
- 5 WHEREAS, This important observance was established in 2004,
- 6 when the U.S. Congress passed a bill designating September 17 as
- 7 the day for citizens to reflect upon the ideals of freedom set forth
- 8 and realized in the U.S. Constitution; in addition, the legislation
- 9 requires the teaching of the Constitution in schools so that our
- 10 future generations will understand the importance of this document,
- 11 which embodies liberty and freedom; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The world's oldest written national charter of
- 13 government, the Constitution created the framework for federal
- 14 governance, and its opening words, "We the People," affirm that the
- 15 government of the United States exists to serve the country's
- 16 citizens; the framers wisely separated and balanced governmental
- 17 powers to safeguard the principle of majority rule and minority
- 18 rights, the ideals of liberty and equality, and the interests of the
- 19 federal and state governments; and
- WHEREAS, In its first three articles, the Constitution
- 21 established a republic representative form of government composed
- 22 of three separate branches, the legislative, executive, and
- 23 judicial; a system of checks and balances limits the powers of each
- 24 branch; two years after the signing, 10 amendments, known as the

- 1 Bill of Rights, were added to guarantee specific civil liberties;
- 2 and
- 3 WHEREAS, A covenant that continues to shape our daily lives,
- 4 the U.S. Constitution has served as the cornerstone of our republic
- 5 for more than two centuries, and it has become an internationally
- 6 celebrated model for creating a system of government of the people,
- 7 by the people, and for the people; now, therefore, be it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas
- 9 Legislature hereby recognize September 17, 2024, as Constitution
- 10 Day and encourage all Texans to learn more about the United States
- 11 Constitution and its vital role in the preservation of the rights
- 12 and freedoms of all Americans.
