R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, William H. Lindley is retiring as Highland Park town
2 administrator on May 26, 2023, drawing to a close a distinguished
3 career in municipal government that has spanned more than four
4 decades; and

5 WHEREAS, Over the course of his 15 years as town
6 administrator, Bill Lindley has played an instrumental role in
7 assisting the town council in implementing a 10-year operating and
8 capital budget; he was integral to the renovation of the town's
9 parks and town hall, as well as improvements to the roads and
10 utility systems; during his tenure, he has ably guided Highland
11 Park through many difficult challenges, including the West Nile
12 virus outbreak, Winter Storm Uri, and the COVID-19 pandemic; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Lindley holds a bachelor's degree and has
14 completed coursework toward a master's degree in public
15 administration, and he received continuing education certification
16 in public management and mediation; prior to joining the Highland
17 Park staff, he held several senior leadership positions with local
18 governments in Gladewater, Rusk, Cedar Hill, DeSoto, and
19 Colleyville, which was the recipient of the 2006 Municipal
20 Excellence Award from the Texas Municipal League while he was city
21 manager; he has been honored with the Jay Sansom Mentor Award from
22 the North Texas City Management Association and the Mentoring Award
23 in Memory of Gary Gwyn from the Texas City Management Association;

2 greatly benefited the Highland Park community, and he may reflect
3 with pride on his many contributions as he begins the next exciting
4 chapter of his life; now, therefore, be it
