RESOLUTION

- BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of 1 Texas, 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, That House Rule 13, 2 3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to 4 resolve the differences on Senate Bill 12 (the authority to 5 regulate sexually oriented performances and to restricting those 6 7 performances on the premises of a commercial enterprise, on public property, or in the presence of an individual younger than 18 years 8 9 of age; authorizing a civil penalty; creating a criminal offense) 10 to consider and take action on the following matter:
- House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4), is suspended to permit the committee to add text on a matter not included in either the house or senate version of the bill in proposed SECTION 3 of the bill, by adding Section 43.28(a)(1)(E), Penal Code, to read as follows:
- 15 <u>(E) the exhibition of sexual gesticulations</u>
 16 <u>using accessories or prosthetics that exaggerate male or female</u>
- 17 <u>sexual characteristics</u>
- Explanation: The change is necessary to add additional conduct to the definition of sexual conduct.
