RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Fire Chief Manuel Mello III has made invaluable 2 contributions to his community during his 35 years of dedicated 3 service to the Eagle Pass Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Chief Mello first joined the department as 4 а volunteer in 1988, before being hired as a full-time employee in 5 1992; he worked on the front lines as a firefighter and emergency 6 7 medical technician for several years, and he was among the Eagle Pass firefighters who were deployed to the massive Eagle Oil fire of 8 9 1994; while he and his colleagues were battling the blaze, he risked his life by driving a burning 18-wheeler away from the scene, which 10 prevented many deaths that may have occurred if a fuel tanker had 11 12 caught fire; and

WHEREAS, As he excelled in his duties, Chief Mello received a 13 14 series of promotions, to lieutenant, acting captain, and assistant fire chief; he took the reins of the department in 2015, and his 15 16 major accomplishments have included implementing new policies and procedures, procuring new vehicles and equipment, and overseeing 17 18 construction of the downtown fire the station and the reconstruction of Station 2; and 19

20 WHEREAS, Along the way, Chief Mello has continued his 21 professional development, earning certifications as a fire 22 instructor, fire officer, and certified fire executive, to name but 23 a few; he also served as the emergency management coordinator for 24 the City of Eagle Pass from 2014 to 2018, and since 2013, he has been

1 involved in the Amistad Border Task Force, a collaboration between 2 the Environmental Protection Agency and its Mexican counterpart to 3 address environmental issues on both sides of the border; and
