R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, On December 10, 2022, Fire Marshal Eleazar Cuevas
2 was honored for 20 years of dedicated service to the City of
3 Eagle Pass; and

4 WHEREAS, First hired by the city in 2002, Mr. Cuevas was
5 promoted to lieutenant in 2013, and later that year, he attended the
6 Middle Rio Grande Regional Law Enforcement Academy; he was
7 appointed a peace officer in 2014, and he went on to join the Fire
8 Marshal's Office as deputy fire marshal; in 2019, he assumed his
9 current role as fire marshal; and

10 WHEREAS, In addition to responding to major fires and
11 accidents in the area over the years, Mr. Cuevas has played an
12 instrumental role in investigating and identifying the
13 perpetrators of several arson fires; moreover, he leads the city's
14 Fire Prevention Program, which reaches more than 5,000 students in
15 local schools and daycare centers, as well as community
16 organizations and residential facilities for seniors; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Cuevas has training in such areas as hazardous
18 materials, confined space rescue, and swift water rescue, and he
19 holds a number of professional certifications, including advanced
20 firefighter, master arson investigator, advanced fire
21 investigator, intermediate peace officer, and emergency medical
22 technician; and

23 WHEREAS, Through his dedication, professionalism, and
24 commitment to excellence, Eleazar Cuevas has earned the lasting

1 respect and admiration of his colleagues and fellow citizens, and
2 it is a pleasure to join in recognizing him for his outstanding
3 record of service; now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 88th Texas
5 Legislature hereby commend Fire Marshal Eleazar Cuevas for his 20
6 years of service to the City of Eagle Pass and extend to him sincere
