1 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Federico Salinas is retiring from the
2 Eagle Pass Fire Department in 2023, drawing to a close more than two
3 decades of dedicated service to the community; and

4 WHEREAS, Mr. Salinas began his career at the Eagle Pass Fire
5 Department in February 2000, and he was promoted to lieutenant in
6 2016; the following year, he obtained his peace officer's license
7 and was appointed deputy fire marshal; over the course of his
8 tenure, he has been an active member on the swift water, high-angle,
9 and hazmat task forces, and he has served as a fire inspector,
10 critical incident stress debriefer, and emergency medical
11 technician; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Salinas has also taught courses at the Eagle
13 Pass In-House Fire and EMS Academy, and he has served as an adjunct
14 instructor for Spanish-language fire courses at Texas A&M
15 Engineering Extension Service; and

16 WHEREAS, Through his dedication, hard work, and commitment to
17 excellence, Federico Salinas has greatly benefited the citizens of
18 Eagle Pass, and he may indeed reflect with pride on a career well
19 spent as he embarks on the next exciting chapter of his life; now,

22 Legislature hereby congratulate Lieutenant Federico Salinas on his
