- 1 WHEREAS, The Del Rio High School boys' track and field team
- 2 achieved great distinction by winning the 91st annual Border
- 3 Olympics, held March 3 and 4, 2023, in Laredo; and
- WHEREAS, The Border Olympics traces its origins to 1932, when
- 5 it started as a track meet then known as the International Frontier
- 6 Olympics; over the years, this celebrated event has grown to
- 7 encompass collegiate golf and tennis tournaments as well as high
- 8 school baseball, softball, soccer, basketball, and cross country
- 9 competitions in addition the track and field contests; and
- WHEREAS, Facing off against athletes from 20 schools in South
- 11 Texas, the Rams tallied a final score of 84 en route to collecting
- 12 their second-straight team championship, besting their nearest
- 13 opponent by 21 points; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Del Rio was especially impressive in the relay
- 15 events; the foursome of Juan Peralta, Emmanuel Devonte Reyes, Zane
- 16 Hughes, and Jovahn West clocked a time of 43.08 seconds in the
- 17 400-meter relay to take home the gold; in the 800-meter relay,
- 18 Mr. Peralta, Ethan Vasquez, Mr. Hughes, and Mr. West won the gold
- 19 and set a meet record with a time of 1 minute, 30.23 seconds;
- 20 moreover, the quartet of Alex Rodriguez, Rolando Rios, Jose Ortiz,
- 21 and Elian De La Paz finished in fifth place in the 1,600-meter
- 22 relay; and
- WHEREAS, In the individual events, Mr. Hughes secured the
- 24 silver medal in the 200-meter dash and was named a top-10 athlete in

- 1 the boys' division; Mr. West also received that honor for his
- 2 performance, which included finishing fifth in the 100-meter dash
- 3 and soaring 21 feet, 10 inches, in the long jump to claim the bronze
- 4 medal; Alan Dobbins placed third in both the high jump, with a leap
- 5 that cleared 6 feet, and in the triple jump, with a distance of 41
- 6 feet, 10.5 inches; fourth-place finishes were garnered by Mr. De La
- 7 Paz in the 400-meter dash, Isaac Jimenez in the shot put, and Manuel
- 8 Padilla in the discus; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The Rams were also represented at the meet by Aaron
- 10 Acosta, Cristian Briones, Jose A. Martinez, Steven McBlain, Perry
- 11 Mcintire, Jonathan Mendoza, Jose Ramirez, Juan Ramos, Andres
- 12 Rivera, Jayden Rivera, Hugo Rosales, Ricardo J. Torres, and Andrew
- 13 Villarreal; these dedicated student-athletes were ably guided by
- 14 head coach Ricardo Torres and assistant coaches Luis Esparza, Ariel
- 15 Falcon, Ramiro Frausto, David Ruiz, and Chris Wren; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The Del Rio Rams have excelled through skill, hard
- 17 work, and an enduring commitment to excellence, and they may
- 18 reflect with pride on a job well done; now, therefore, be it
