## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 SECTION 1. Section 48.2552(b), Education Code, is amended

- 12 SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 48, Education Code, is

- 15 SCHOOL YEAR. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title
- or Chapter 26, Tax Code, for the 2023-2024 school year, the
- 17 commissioner shall calculate the value of a school district's
- 18 maximum compressed tax rate by determining the district's maximum
- 19 compressed rate under Section 48.2551 or 48.2552(b), if applicable,
- 20 and reducing the tax rate determined under the applicable section
- 21 by the amount by which the commissioner may reduce each district's
- 22 maximum compressed tax rate by an equal amount using money
- 23 appropriated for the purpose of reducing each district's maximum
- 24 compressed tax rate under this section.
