- 2 relating to the methods by which the comptroller may provide notice
- 3 of a hearing on the revocation or suspension, or of the revocation

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 111.0047, Tax Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (d) Notices under this section may be served on the holder
- 10 of the permit or license personally or may be mailed to the holder's
- 11 address as shown in the records of the comptroller. At the option
- 12 of the holder of the permit or license, the notices may be served by
- 13 <u>electronic means instead of served personally or mailed.</u>
- 14 (e) A notice served by electronic means must be addressed to
- 15 the person's e-mail address as it appears in the comptroller's
- 16 <u>records. Service by electronic means</u> is complete when the
- 17 comptroller transmits the notice to the person's e-mail address.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
