- 13 $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ at least one year of work experience acceptable
- 14 to the board, including experience providing a service or advice
- 15 involving accounting, attest services, management or financial

- 17 the board considers appropriate for an accountant, if the person:

- 21 SECTION 4. Sections 901.252 and 901.256(a), Occupations

- 26 governed by the law in effect on the date the application was

- 2 SECTION 5. Section 901.254, Occupations Code, as amended by
- 3 this Act, applies only to an application to take an examination
- 4 submitted on or after the effective date of this Act. An

- 6 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the
- 7 application was submitted, and the former law is continued in
- 8 effect for that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
